

Mr. Warren J. Parsons is a Chief Architect at the General Motors Company. He is currently responsible for all vehicle architectures for Advanced Vehicle Development. Prior to this position he was responsible for the upper body structure design of the GM rear wheel drive luxury vehicles. Past assignments include the design of the previous generation rear wheel drive luxury vehicle body-in white, and its variations, as well as that of the front wheel drive large luxury platform.
